Located on 2000 acres in the magnificent Madison Valley, the Homestead House on the 7HC Ranch is a haven for those who love sunshine, space and a laid-back relaxing environment.

The 7HC Ranch is about five miles north of Ennis, Montana, and one mile west of the fabled Madison River. It is nestled along the river in the seven-mile wide Madison Valley between the Madison and Tobacco Root Ranges.

Sportsmen have long considered the Madison River to be one of the premier fly fishing rivers in the world. Rainbow and brown trout provide a never-ending challenge and is beloved by both waders and drift-boat anglers.

The ranch owners have a long-time relationship with a local outfitter who can arrange fishing, big-game hunting (both bow and rifle), bird hunting and horseback riding. The joy of seeing one's son or grandson reel in his first trout is an amazing memory for everyone.

- 75 miles south brings you to the wonders of Yellowstone National Park & Old Faithful
- 14 miles west takes you to the past with a visit to Virginia City, the first territorial capital, in the middle of the 1863 gold rush. Lively in the summer with the Brewery Follies, the vaudeville Opera House, charming shops, mercantile store, homemade candy and handmade ice cream.
- Nevada City, an 1860s town, which also hosts the world's largest collection of working calliopes, is just another mile down the road.
- Day trips to Bozeman, Butte, Lewis and Clark Caverns, Three Forks, where the Jefferson, Madison and Gallatin Rivers meet to form the Missouri River.
- Lone Mountain, the site of Big Sky Resort and ski slopes is visible from the ranch.
- The beach at Ennis Lake is just 6 miles away.

The Homestead House is a two-story log home built in the 1880s. In the interest of preserving our heritage, the Homestead House has undergone a year-long renovation, utilizing the best possible combination of the old and the new. The house features four bedrooms (sleeping 8 comfortably), two baths, living room, dining area, and fully-equipped kitchen. The ranch is ideal for family vacations as there are a multitude of activities for adults, teens and the younger set, either on the ranch or nearby. The beauty of the magnificent Rocky Mountains, both east and west of the ranch, and the deep blue sky will take your breath away and tug at your heart strings forever.
